Is your child eligible for subsidised or free music lessons?

Cornwall Music **Education Hub**

The Cornwall Music Education Hub is committed to ensuring wider access to music for all children and young people. In order to do this, the Hub manages funding from the Designated Schools grant to help provide free or subsidised instrumental/vocal tuition for school-age children attending Cornish schools.

If the child meets one of the following criteria and are receiving lessons from a Hub Registered Provider they will be entitled to a 100% subsidy up to £5.00 per lesson:

- Currently eligible for Free School Meals (not including FSM universal entitlement for Infants School pupils)
- · Currently in Care
- One or more parents/carers in the household are currently serving in the British armed forces

If the child meets the following criteria and is receiving lessons from a Hub Registered Provider they will be entitled 50% subsidy up to £2.50 per lesson:

 Parent/carer in the child's household or child learning is in receipt of Disability Living Allowance (Personal Independence Payment)

If you think that you would be eligible for music lesson subsidies, please speak to your school or provider of tuition.

There are also subsidies available for CMEH instrument hire and CMEH orchestra/choir/ensemble membership.
