The Dante Quartet has performed many times at the Wigmore Hall and Britain's other top chamber music venues, are frequently heard on Radio 3 and have performed across Europe and in Japan. Their recordings have won high praise and awards including the BBC Music Magazine Award and the French Diapason d'Or and the quartet have been recipients of the Royal Philharmonic Society Award for Chamber Music.

The arrangement of Arensky's Andante for quartet and string orchestra was devised by Tim Boulton and the Dante Quartet for a concert at St. Germans in July, but proved so popular that they are performing this work again with both the East Cornwall and Penzance Youth String Orchestras.
