How do we know which venue our school will be performing at?

We will be contact with all schools very soon to explain venue allocations.

How many students will we be able to bring to the event?

10 students per school. We will not be able to increase this number for any school as we are extremely limited on numbers at every venue. We will however be hosting a virtual aspect to Songfest this year so the whole school can join in.

How many teachers can accompany the choir group?

In line with your school trip ratios. Please ensure your group has at least 1 teacher and another adult chaperone.

Will there be a dress rehearsal prior to the concert?

Yes, dress rehearsal dates to be confirmed.

How will schools get to the venue?

Schools are required to arrange their own transport to and from rehearsals and concerts.

What time will schools need to arrive to the venue on concert day?

Arrival is usually by 3:30pm but we will confirm this closer to the concert date.

How will parents buy tickets to the event?

Tickets will be released via a ticketing agent. Details to be sent to the schools direct as this may depend on the venue for their concert.

How much will the tickets cost?

Tickets will be £6 per adult and £3 per child, plus any booking fees.

What will the students need to wear for the live concerts?

Black trousers/skirts, black socks/tights, black shoes and their Songfest t-shirt. All pupils taking part in the live concerts will receive a free Songfest T-Shirt to wear at the performance and keep following the event. We will contact schools to request numbers and sizes.

What time does the concert start and finish?

Concert timings at 7.00pm-8.45pm approx.

Do children need to bring a packed tea to the event?

Children will need to bring a packed tea and water bottles.

Can the children leave after the rehearsal?

We strongly recommend students stay in their school groups between the rehearsal and concert as rehearsal timings can change on the day.
